Introduction

1. WNK Aviation LLC ("**Company**," "**we**" or "**us**") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with the following provisions ("**Privacy Policy**").
2. This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you access and use <https://www.wnkaviation.com/> including any content, functionality and service ("**Service**") offered on or through such website (the "**Website**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.
3. This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect:
 1. On the Website.
 2. When you interact with other websites and services that include links to this Privacy Policy.
4. This Privacy Policy does not apply to information collected by:
 1. Us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by any third party.
 2. Any third party, including through any application or content that may link to or be accessible from the Website.
5. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, you may not access or use the Website. By accessing or using the Website, you agree to this Privacy Policy.

Intended Users

1. Users in the US. This Privacy Policy is targeted to users in the United States ("**US**") is governed by and operated in accordance with the laws of the US. We

disclaim any representation or liability that the Website is operated in accordance with the laws of other jurisdictions.

2. Not intended for Children Under 13. The Website is not intended for children under 13 years of age. No one under age 13 may provide any information to or on the Website. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you are under 13, do not provide any information to the Website or make any purchases through the Website. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It.

1. Types of Information. We collect several types of information from and about users of the Website, including:
 1. Personal information about you ("**personal information**") such as:
 1. Business information, name and email address when you contact us through our website.
 2. Information that is about you but does not identify you such as online habits, preferences, etc.
 3. Technical information about your device and connection such as:
 1. Preferences: Time zone, language, zoom size, etc.
 2. Identifiers: IP address; mobile device SIM/identifier, etc.
 3. Type: type of device, operating system or platform (Mac, Windows), browser information (type, version), etc.
 4. Connection: Internet provider or mobile carrier name, connection speed and connection type; internet service provider, etc.
 5. External pages: URL of the last and next page visited, etc.
 6. Use of the Website: Data, pages viewed, time spent on a page, click through, clickstream data, queries made, search results selected, history, comments made, etc.
 7. Location: Geographic and network location, etc.
4. How We Collect. We collect this information:

1. Directly from you when you type or transmit it to us, including:
 1. Information that you provide by filling in forms on the Website. Information requested by us when you report a problem with the Website.
 2. Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
2. Automatically as you navigate through the Website. Information collected automatically may include:
 1. Usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons and other tracking technologies.
 2. Preferences and settings: time zone, language and character size
 3. Identifiers: computer IP address; unique mobile device identifier
 4. Technical information: type of device, operating system or platform (Mac, Windows), browser information (type, version)
 5. Connection: Internet provider or mobile carrier name, connection speed and connection type; Internet service provider (ISP)
 6. URL of the last Web page visited before visiting our Service; exit page
 7. Information about your use of the website: data stamp, pages viewed, time spent on a page, click through, clickstream data, queries made, search results selected, history, comments made
 8. Location: general geographic location
3. Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies. As you navigate through and interact with the Website, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

1. Details of your visits to the Website, including traffic data and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
2. Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.
3. The information we collect automatically is generally statistical data that does not include personal information, but we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve the Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:
 1. Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
 2. Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize the Website according to your individual interests.
 3. Speed up your searches.
 4. Recognize you when you return to the Website.
4. The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:
 1. A cookie is a small file we place on your device that tracks your usage. You may refuse to accept browser cookies the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of the Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to the Website.
 2. Web Beacons. Pages of the Website and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags,

and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity).

Third-Party Use of Cookies, Tracking and Links.

The information they collect may be associated with your personal information or they may collect information, including personal information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. How We Use Your Information.

1. We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information, for the following purposes:
2. To provide the Service: We use your information to operate the Website and provide the Service to you. 1. We may disclose anonymized and aggregated information about our users without restriction.
2. We may disclose information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information, to the following third parties:
3. Group companies: To our subsidiaries and affiliates in common control.
4. Service providers: To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and not to disclose it, and to use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
5. Buyer/successor: To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by us about the Website users is among the assets transferred.
6. Other users with access: To other users who have been provided with access to your Portal in accordance with this Privacy Policy for the purpose of accessing or sharing User Contributions.
7. Advertisers: Even though we do not disclose your personal information to advertisers, third party advertisers may set cookies, web beacons or other technologies on the Website to collect information about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services,

in order to make our advertising on our Website or elsewhere on the internet more relevant to you.

8. Other purposes: We may also disclose your personal information for the following purposes:
9. To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

11. If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property or safety of us, our customers or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.
12. To allow us to pursue available remedies or limit the damages we may sustain.
13. As necessary or appropriate to otherwise address unlawful or harmful activity.
14. For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information, or otherwise with your consent.
